Suresh Senan, MRCP, FRCR, PhD

Suresh Senan is Professor of clinical experimental radiotherapy at the VU University Medical Center in Amsterdam, and vice-chairman of the Department of Radiation Oncology. In 1988, he commenced training in radiotherapy and oncology at the Beatson Oncology Centre in the United Kingdom, where he also performed his PhD research on preclinical and early clinical pharmacology of tirapazamine. He moved to Erasmus Medical Center in The Netherlands in 1994, and to the VU University Medical Center in Amsterdam in 2002. His research group has been active in 4-dimensional imaging for radiotherapy planning, guideline development for image-guided radiotherapy, implementation of volumetric modulated arc therapy, clinical trials of radiotherapy combined with new agents, and comparative effectiveness research.
